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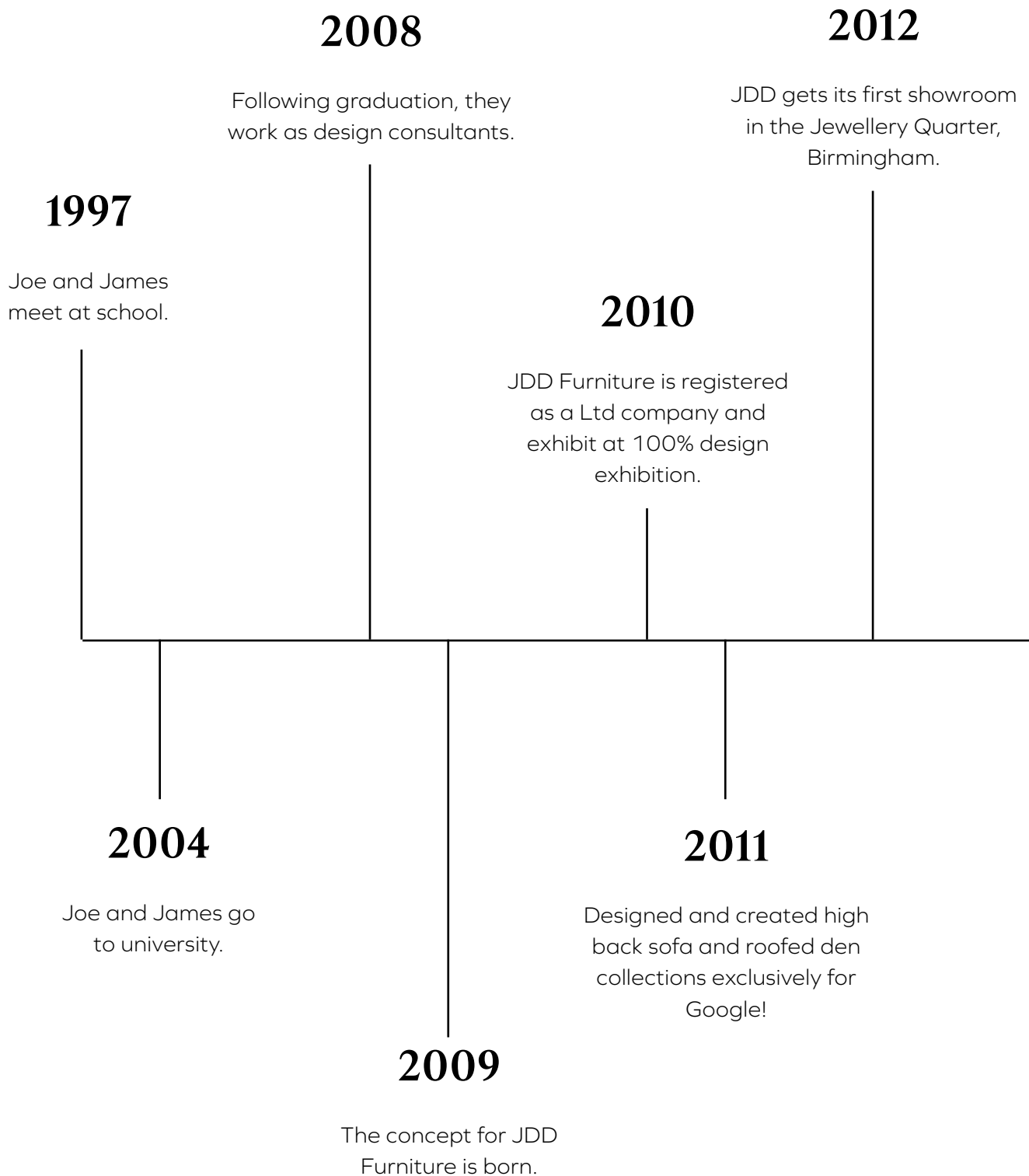


Who we are

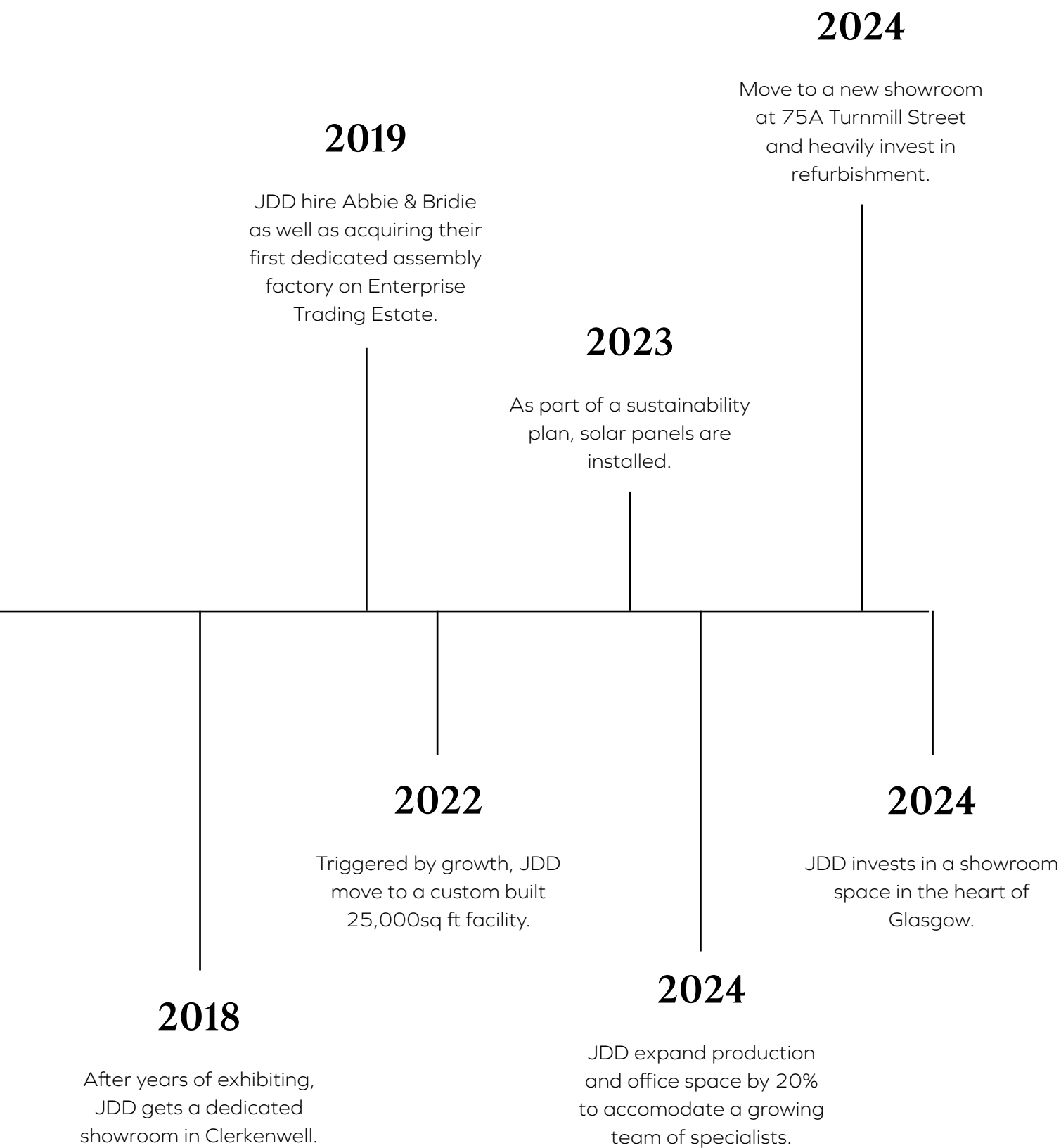

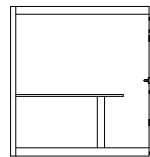
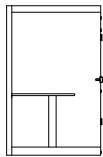
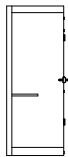
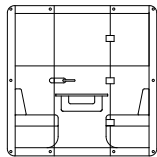
Why use a meeting pod?

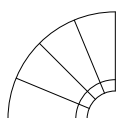
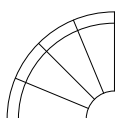
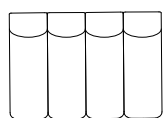
Benefits of banquette seats?

They also enhance employee well being and comfort, contributing to a more engaging and productive work atmosphere.



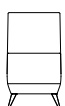
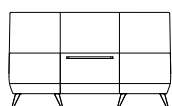

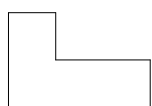
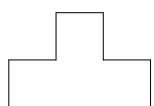
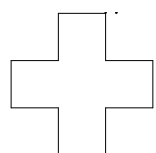


Benefits of modular?

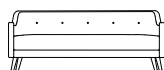
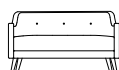
Why use soft seating?

Soft seating can also encourage more informal interactions, fostering a collaborative and innovative team workplace culture.

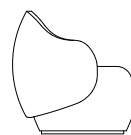
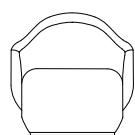

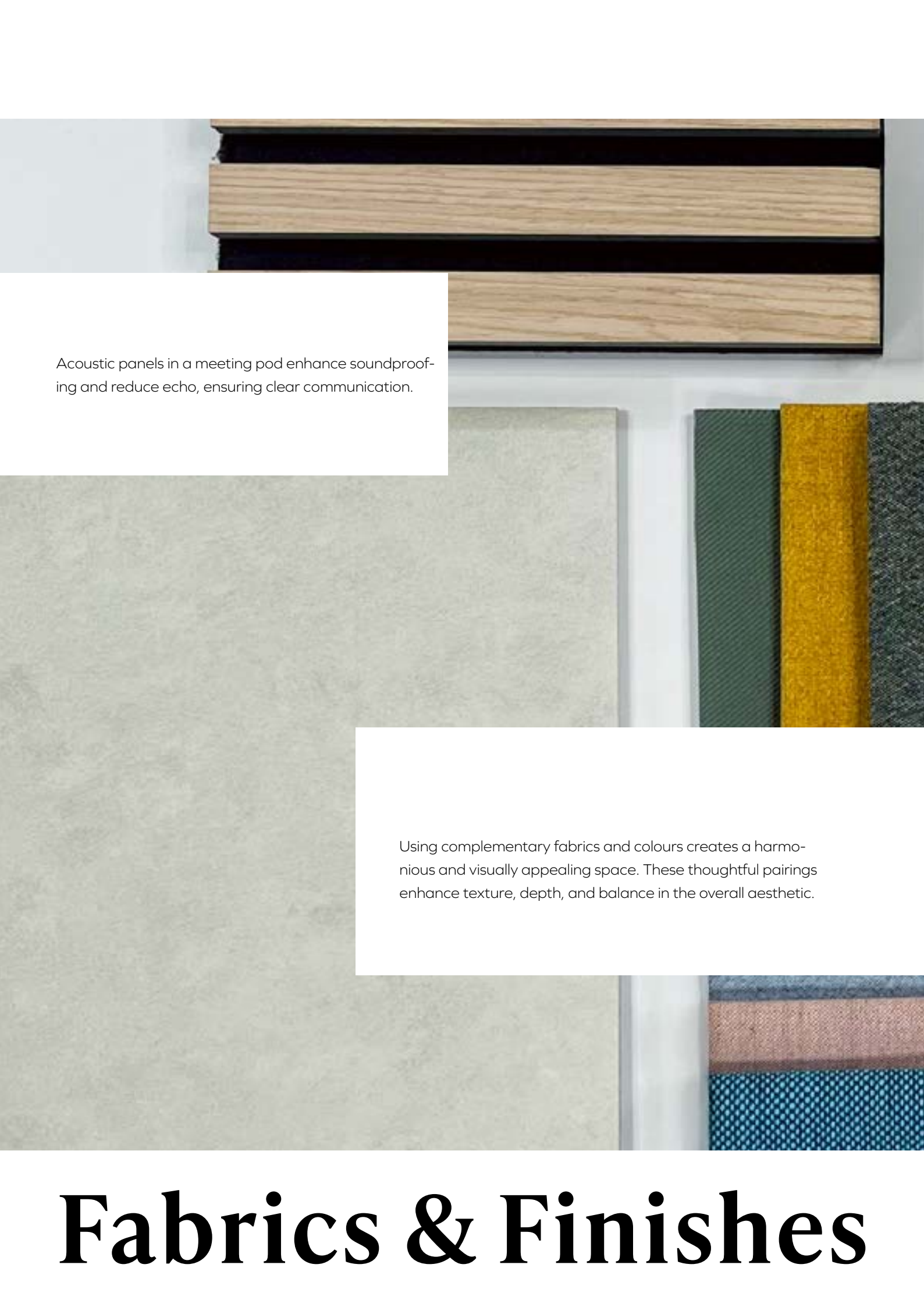
What is a media unit?
